



Please read through this information carefully before submitting any forms.

Following receipt of your results, you may feel that the marks you have received do not truly reflect your ability. You therefore have the opportunity to re sit your summer 2021 exams in the Autumn term should you wish to improve your grade.

GCE exams will take place between 4th and 22nd October 2021.

GCSE exams will be between 1st November and 3rd December 2021.

Cambridge Technicals/BTEC/EPQ - Autumn exams are not available.

The Autumn results will be based on your exam performance alone – Except for Art and Design qualifications, grades will be determined by students' performance in the exams only – there will be no non-exam assessments. Exams will be in their normal format with no adaptations being made (other than reasonable adjustments for students with special educational needs or disabilities). In Art & Design, grades will be based on your performance in a new task, set and marked by the exam board and taken under the normal supervised conditions. You will be notified of the dates and times of all your exams in September. Please note **these are not mandatory exams**.

Regardless of where you intend to study for post-16, here with us or elsewhere, should you intend to sit your GCSEs or A Levels in the autumn term, your exam will be held at Wolverhampton Grammar School.

If you wish to make an entry for the Autumn exam series please fill in the Intention to re-sit form indicating which subjects you wish to be entered for.

Students leaving Wolverhampton Grammar School

You must enclose payment for all requested services – entry will not be processed without prior payment. On the rear of each cheque please write **candidate name, subject, exam board** and **the service you requested**. Exam board entry fees can be found in the intention to resit form.

Students continuing to study at Wolverhampton Grammar School

You will be billed at a later date.

Exam Certificates

If you are continuing your studies at WGS your certificates will be issued during an assembly slot in December 2021.

If you are leaving WGS you must collect your certificates from Main Reception. **We cannot post out exam certificates.**

Whether leaving or remaining at WGS you must sign to say you have received your certificates as they are your responsibility.

Please note that WGS is only obliged to keep certificates for one year following receipt of results; following this, certificates must be destroyed. If you do not collect your certificates within one year of your exam results it is your responsibility to contact the exam boards who will charge you for a statement confirming your grades.
